Who do we help?

Family Support Network serves over 400 families in the Billings area who are at risk for abuse and neglect. Our specialists provide home visits, transportation, referrals and education in budgeting, nutrition, safety, and nurturing parenting. These services help families remain safe, healthy, independent and most importantly **together**.

How can I help?

For the first time in 25 years, our Covid-19 policies preclude us from serving through our Adopt-a-Family program. Donations received this holiday season will help us give a special gift of pajamas, books, small treats and any needed items to each of the children we serve. They will also allow us to assist families in the reunification process throughout the year with essential purchases in order to create a safe and nurturing home for their children.
